PROJECT RESULT 1: COMPETENCE FRAMEWORK DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT (ONGOING)

GIF Competence Framework will be complemented by annexes designed for boosting replicability, adoption and exploitation, and specifically:

- a User Guide (for educators, training providers and enterprise Human Resources), that will provide practical information and guidelines for implementing the GIF Competence Framework in education and training programs
- a set of Use Cases, that will provide reports about current implementations performed during the GIF project



PROJECT RESULT 2: TRAINING KIT DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING

The training kit will be composed of:

- training contents for individual learning (videolessons, presentations, booklets, further readings, bibliographies and selection of relevant websites)
- training activities guides, providing examples of assignments and interactive activities such as collaborative project works, interactive classes, course scheduling and orchestration graphs
- assessment methodologies and criteria for certificate provision
