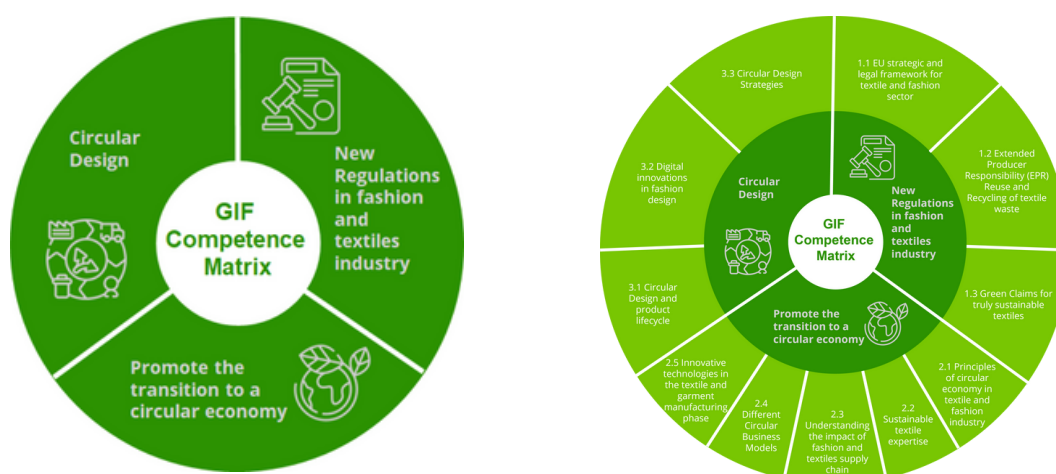

## PROJECT RESULT 1: COMPETENCE FRAMEWORK DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT (AVAILABLE ON THE PROJECT WEBPAGE)

The **GIF Competence Framework** will be complemented by a User's Guide (for educators, training providers and HR managers in companies), which will contain practical information and guidelines for implementing the GIF Competence Framework in education and training programmes.



## PROJECT RESULT 2: TRAINING KIT DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING (ONGOING)

The **training kit** will be composed of:

- training contents for individual learning (videolessons, presentations, booklets, further readings, bibliographies and selection of relevant websites)
- training activities guides, providing examples of assignments and interactive activities such as collaborative project works, interactive classes, course scheduling and orchestration graphs
- assessment methodologies and criteria for certificate provision



## MULTIPLIER EVENT

During the month of May, the entire GIF consortium held its multiplier events, involving VET suppliers, representatives of fashion industry companies, SMEs, trainers, interested students and consumers, environmental consultants and public authorities. The main objective was achieved with important feedback that gives value to the project objective. The expert participants from **Germany, Spain, Italy, Romania and Greece** agreed that the GIF results (competency framework and curriculum) are up-to-date and in line with the fashion professionals' needs and requests

In June (1st and 2nd) **IEF** had the opportunity to present the results of the project at the 10th Slow Fashion Next Sustainable Fashion Conference, organized by Slow Fashion Next, pioneers in sustainable fashion training since 2011.



## NEXT STEPS

- The consortium is working on the Curriculum Design, developing the training contents of the GIF.
- The next activities will be the preparation and implementation of the pilot course.
