- Get acquainted with the **GIF Competence Framework**, modeled after the European Qualifications Framework (EQF), emphasizing EQF levels 4-5.
- Use the <u>GIF Curriculum</u> (now available) to compile educational unit(s) alongside online training courses and a training kit, offering comprehensive resources for each topic across the three Competence levels.



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COURSES AND PLATFORM GUIDE AVAILABLE!

The **GIF** short learning programme (FREE) consists of three (3) Modules composed of ten (10) Units. The core element of each unit consists of video lectures linked with activities for learning by doing, potentially including interactive exercises, assignments, simulations, and case studies.
